- Understands how to fit bearings, align gears and shafts, attach motors, and connect couplings and belts to precise tolerances
- Aligns and tests equipment to make any necessary adjustments
- Performs predictive and operational maintenance using procedures such as vibration analysis, and repair or replace defective parts when necessary
- Services and repairs hydraulic, pneumatic and programmable logic controls
- May do some tack welding (a weld that is adequate in size to temporarily hold components in place until it can be completely welded by a registered apprentice welder or a journeyman welder) and fabrication as well as maintain an inventory of replacement parts
- May perform other related duties as assigned

Requirements:

- Must have a Journeyman Millwright ticket from a recognized provincial training authority/provide proof of Journeyman hours
- Must have previous experience working in an industrial setting
- Must have previous experience working in a maintenance setting
- Must successfully complete pre-access drug and alcohol testing
- Must possess valid CSTS .09 (Construction Safety Training Systems) certification
- Must possess valid OSSA (Oil Sands Safety Association) Regional certification/BPO
- Must possess valid H2S Alive certification
- Must possess a valid form of government issued photo identification
- Must have demonstrated ability to work under minimal supervision

Work Conditions:

- Applicants that reside in Edmonton and Calgary will be given preference due to travel arrangements
- Camp based position with full accommodations provided
- 7/7 rotation 12 hours of work/day
- By hand welders only No RIGs
- Charter flights provided from Edmonton and Calgary
